- 3. IL 173 CORRIDOR PLAN: In October 1994, RATS adopted a corridor access plan for IL 173 between IL 251 and Belvidere Road. Since that time, the planned development that was anticipated to occur in this corridor is currently underway. As a result of the economic and residential development in the past six-years, the construction of the planned interchange at Interstate 39/90 (Northwest Tollway), and future growth capability in this section of Winnebago County / Loves Park / Machesney Park, an updated access plan has been prepared to facilitate travel patterns that are expected to occur within the planning horizon. At the May 25, 2006 Policy Committee meeting, an update plan was adopted by the RATS Policy Committee. Since that time, the Village of Machesney Park has received another request for access from IL 173. The Technical Committee will be discussing this issue.
